As of 1st January 2006, all harnesses used in MSA events must be FIA homologated and in date. This mandatory FIA homologation has brought the UK into line with the rest of Europe. Harnesses are clearly identified by an FIA homologation which is sewn into the webbing near the quick release buckle. All parts of the harness must have a valid FIA homologation label and be identified as being part of the same set. The FIA homologation label states "NOT VALID AFTER (Date)". Once this date has expired the harness is no longer FIA homologated and will be refused if presented for scrutineering.
